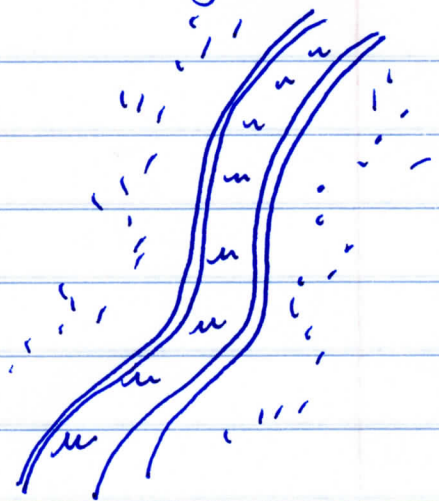


## Aqueducts

aqueduct - a structure that carries large amounts of water from one place to another.

- ① California Aqueduct
- ② Los Angeles Aqueduct
- ③ Colorado River Aqueduct



LA gets water from:

- Mono Lake - limited
- Owens River - limited
- Colorado River - many communities share this source

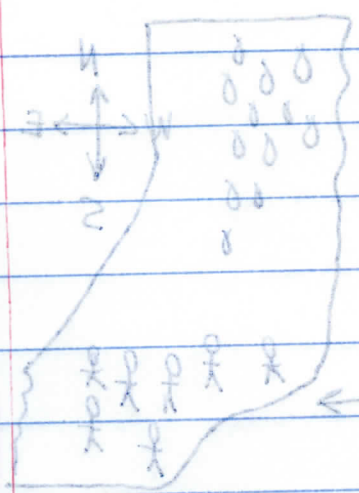
